Course Requirements

Eligibility to Study

- Australian Resident or Citizen (ask about eligibility for Government funding).
- For non Australian Residents or Citizens, we conduct a VEVO check through the Department of Immigration.

Enrolment Appointment

- Phone and book your enrolment appointment with a member of our training staff on (08) 9439 1673.
- Provide Photo ID (Driver's License or Passport)
- Provide Proof of Residency / Citizenship (Birth Certificate / Passport).
- Be reasonably fit and physically capable of performing the role.
- Meet the foundation skills (literacy and numeracy levels) necessary to perform in the role.
- Be able to attend and complete the training room and practical components of the course.
- Deposit of \$1000 to secure enrolment.

Intake dates are subject to class availability

Placement (Work Experience) Requirements

- Provide a clear National Criminal History Check (Police Clearance) no more than 6 months old.
- Wear suitable pants and enclosed, non-slip footwear (uniform shirt provided by Bestwest Care).
- Placements are to be completed Monday to Friday (no night shifts, weekends or public holidays).
