Choose either <u>Non-Accredited</u> or <u>Accredited</u> course options. Both require one day in class (theory and practical). The difference between the two is Accredited option requires a Workplace Assessment, organised by the learner.

Full Unit of Competency (Accredited) \$250 per person

- The theory of assisting with medications
- The practical skills required
- A practical workplace assessment (see criteria below)

Statement of Attainment is issued on completion.

Part Unit of Competency (Non-Accredited) \$125 per person

- The theory of assisting with medications
- The practical skills required

Statement of Participation is issued on completion.

Workplace Assessment Criteria (Accredited only)

To complete the Full Unit of Competency (Accredited) HLTHPS006 Assist Clients with Medications, the learner is to attend the above one-day class and then undertake a workplace assessment.

The learner arranges their own workplace assessment, which is to be undertaken by an employee in their own workplace who is either a qualified registered nurse or registered enrolled nurse or registered Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander health practitioner. (Assessors must satisfy the standards for RTOs 2015/AQTF mandatory competency requirements).

Learners are to follow workplace policies, procedures and regulatory requirements. They will need to demonstrate providing assistance with medication:

- To at least 5 different clients according to support plans
- With at least 5 different types of medication
- Using at least 3 different modes of administration
